On Tuesday night the Compton water board discussed the bill which was recently sent To Us by your company. We are currently seeking a loan to try to get the Telemetry switch upgraded by your company, however it will obviously take some time and our bylaws require us to get at least one other bid. The person from your company did come here and provide services however when he left he thought the system was up and running temporarily and it immediately stopped working when he left. We had previously contacted our phone company and had them to check our phone lines up to the tank and so that variable had already been eliminated. Labels that he put on our control panel I suppose are helpful although I don't ever use them. The rest of the services provided including some drawings for the estimate are helpful as well however we feel that \$760 is a little bit high for what has been accomplished and the estimate given. We are a very small system and like most small systems we struggle financially. It would be greatly appreciated if you could reconsider the amount owed by the Compton Water Association.
