Monthly Meeting Minutes Held at Compton School, Compton Arkansas April 9, 2013 7:00 p.m.

Meeting was called to order by Mitch Jones who asked John Berry if there was a quorum present to conduct; John Berry affirmed there was. Present were: John Berry, Mitch Jones, John Henderson, Sandy Irwin. Bookkeeper Veronica Oitker.

REPORTS:

MINUTES: Motion made by John Berry and second by John Henderson to accept minutes of previous meeting. Motion carried.

DIRECTORS REPORT: Directors Report was submitted into minutes by John Berry who reviewed it. John reported there was repair on several leaks and is searching for a large leak and unable to find it as of this date. He reported Arkansas Natural Resources was assisting us with locating and repairing leaks. A 40 % water loss for last two months is a large amount and a significant issue and we need to keep searching for them to get the amount reduced.

WATER OPERATOR REPORT: Bobby Hudson not present.

METER READER REPORT: Tom Gandy was present and reported a member had mentioned he wanted his meter read each month but Tom informed him we did read his meter each month.

BOOKKEEPER REPORT: Veronica submitted Bookkeeper reports into minutes. Auditor report was passed but not in writing. Auditor recommended we change from savings accounts to checking accounts to transfer money from one account to another with checks. Auditor noted there was a high water loss, more this year than last year and he noted we couldn't stand those kinds of losses and we needed to keep looking for them. Motion was made by John Henderson and second by Sandy Irwin to accept reports in to meeting, motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Update on water tank by John Berry John reported that ARNR voted to send it to committee and it looks like its going through.
- 2. Building update John indicated he looked at portable buildings and they were unsatisfactory. He said we needed to hold up a little while until these leaks are under control.

NEW BUSINESS:

REQUEST TO BE ON AGENDA;

Wanda Roudabush - Roudabush wanted to make note the minutes should be read at the public meeting and approved for the benefit of the public. She alleged CWA was having private meetings and it was against State Law and the By Laws of CWA. She claimed CWA was to have 9 members on the Board instead of 5. She produced By Laws and Articles of Incorporation for CWA which she proceeded to read regarding the number of Board Members. She complained the Secretary position

isn't a paid position. She had in her possession some letters of complaint which she didn't leave with the Board. She alleged these were things she saw the Board doing wrong. President Mitch was able to address some of the issues: No private meetings have been engaged by CWA. Jones said that having 5 Board Members is within the Boards rights; we sought legal council on meetings, on FOIA we are also seeking legal council on. An argument ensued between Wanda Roudabush and other members which was confusing and inaudible. President Jones was unable to answer the allegations which Roudabush brought forth.

Garland Matlock brought forth information on the 911 address coming forth and suggested the Board get involved with them so we can have the necessary information to conduct business.

No further business, motion was made by John Henderson to adjourn, second by John Berry, motion carries.
