Monthly Meeting Minutes Held at Compton School, Compton Arkansas February 12, 2013 7:00 p.m.

Meeting was called to order by Mitch Jones who asked John Berry if there was a quorum present to conduct; John Berry affirmed there was. Present were: John Berry, Mitch Jones, John Henderson, Sandy Irwin, Roger Jones. Bookkeeper Veronica Oitker.

#### REPORTS:

MINUTES: Motion made by John Berry and second by John Henderson to accept minutes of previous meeting. Motion carried.

DIRECTORS REPORT: Directors Report was submitted into minutes by John Berry who reviewed it. John reported there were 3 major leaks and the cost of CWA which was \$5,000.00 in water loss. He reported there were some plans to repair them and because they keep breaking. One that is in a creek near Kingston needs attention.

WATER OPERATOR REPORT: Bobby Hudson not present.

METER READER REPORT: No report.

BOOKKEEPER REPORT: Veronica submitted Bookkeeper reports into minutes. Explanation was offered on Depreciation (maintenance) account which is to be used to maintain the system. Motion was made by Roger Jones and second by John Henderson to accept them into minutes. Motion carried.

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

1. None

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1. Procedure was put in place for water members to request information from CWA under the FOIA. The procedure is that information can be requested in writing, .10 cents per copy, \$5.00 handing fee per request, plus postage and information provided within a 30 day period. Motion was made to adopt procedure by Sandy Irwin and second by John Berry. Procedure adopted.
- 2. John updated the Board on painting the tank and the grant coming forth. Arkansas Rural Water Association inspected the tank and it needs to be painted inside and out. Paperwork has been submitted; total project will cost \$90,000, we requested a grant and loan from Arkansas Natural Resources. A request of grant is \$67,500 or 75% and a loan of 25% of \$22,500 is requested by CWA to ANRC for funding. Much conversation was had regarding the grant process and how the monies will be paid out. John said as soon as the grant/loan is approved then it will be put up for bid and anything over \$10,000 will be handled by ESI. There will be a \$5,000 per day water loss during the repair and an estimated time frame isn't determined for completion.

- SW Boone had their annual meeting and determined that they would not increase the water rates to CWA for the next 12 months. In addition, they thanked CWA for paying all past due amounts and our account is now current with them.
- 4. Storage building: John Berry expressed a need to have a storage unit for parts and accessories used to repair leaks, currently they are kept in the well house and when inspected by health department they have commented these are not to be stored in well house. Also, John Berry expressed we need a place to have our files and paper work. It was recommended that the Board meet at the well house property and come up with a plan for a storage building/office. Mitch Jones wanted 3 options presented at next meeting and vote then on which one to choose. Roger Jones wanted to set a time for the Board to meet at the site for suggestions and solutions. Roger made motion that the Board get together and come up with 3 prices and suggestions, second by John Henderson, motion carries.

No further business, motion was made by John Berry to adjourn, second by John Henderson, motion
