COMPTON WATER ASSOCIATION

Monthly Meeting Minutes Held at Compton School, Compton Arkansas June 8, 2010 7:00 p.m.

Meeting called to order by Allen Armer, Secretary John Berry confirmed there was not a quorum. Allen Armer extended meeting until 7:30 p.m. anticipating Clark Shaver and Chris Shaver would be in attendance.

In attendance: Allen Armer, John Berry, Alexa Davis Veronica Oitker Bookkeeper Bobby Hudson, Water Operator applicant Tom Gandy, Meter Reader applicant

Allen Armer stated we were in an emergency state and declared that Compton Water Association could not function without a Water Operator or Meter Reader; therefore we would proceed with both of these applicants as temporary hires until a quorum vote could be declared at the next scheduled meeting and both applicants would be hired at the full pay scale.

At 7:30 p.m., Allen Armer once again asked Secretary John Berry for a quorum, he confirmed there was not a quorum. Allen Armer scheduled the next meeting for Tuesday June 15, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. at Compton School. At 7:30 p.m., Allen Armer adjourned the formal meeting.

Allen Armer asked the members if they had any questions:

One member asked for clarification on what a shutoff meter or disconnected meter is, answer was supplied by John Berry.

John Berry addressed the members regarding how much money CWA owes and reminded them of the outstanding debt and added some clarification to the figures. The amount owed to SW Boone was declared to be approx. \$87,000.00 which excludes penalties and will continue to exclude penalties as long as CWA is able to pay the water usage, taxes and some on delinquent amount. A question was asked about the USDA loan amount, John stated the balance was approx. \$72,000 not \$17,000 which was given in a previous meeting; it was explained that the \$17,000 was the past due amount (which was 3 years in arrears) and the loan balance is approx. \$72,000.00. The truck balance is \$388.23 and will be paid off in June. John also reported that the taxes hadn't been done in 2008 and 2009 and the past accountant Leila Hutton was proceeding to do the taxes with back up disc's from those years.

Allen said that it would be nice if people would answer the call to serve as Board Members; at this meeting 3 were missing, one threatening to resign and we were unable to conduct business. He was hoping others would be ready to commit to serve. Explanation was given as to why the other members weren't in attendance.

One member asked what the water loss for the month was; it was declared it was approx. 1,000,000 gallons, we had a major leak. 2,127,000 supplied to system, we sold 975,000 gallons. Josh with Arkansas Rural Water was a great help in locating leaks and establishing the condition of

our system and giving assistance in any way to help Compton Water. The leak was found in the Erbie Road area.

A member asked if CWA had ever noticed any paper work regarding fire hydrants that had been purchased and possibly returned. John Berry declared that we were not comfortable with searching for documents due to the investigation currently going on with CWA. Until or unless the investigation is over or completed it would not be wise for any CWA Board Member or Bookkeeper to proceed with searching for documents.

Garland Matlock declared there was a fire hydrant next to the fire department which is improperly plumbed and wouldn't be able to fill a truck. Mr. Matlock wishes that the hydrant be installed correctly half between the driveways to make it easy to fill trucks and could the Fire Department work with CWA to complete the project. Both the Fire Department and CWA declared it was a community safety issue the way they are. Garland said there were opportunities to get funds to help with these improvements; Allen asked Garland to keep him informed about the availability of these funds.

Allen gave an update on the investigation and though it was proceeding, it was still going to require authorization by local authorities in this jurisdiction to proceed and the conflict of interest with these authorities and the investigation was still an obstacle. They were waiting for further information to come forward.
